What's needed for a successful program? The definition of biodiesel is found in IC 6-6-2.5-1.5 under Department of Revenue authority for tax purposes. Regulating biodiesel quality is not within the capability of the DOR. W&M indicated the IN legislative session ends on 4/30 and no progress was made to modify IC 16-44-2 to authorize the Dept of Health to enforce the quality of biodiesel and diesel in Indiana. W&M suggests that industry or associations write letters requesting IN W&M adopt into regulation the Uniform Engine Fuel Regulations published in the 2009 version of HB130.

AUTHORITY

Fuel Authority Regulatory (state regulations); Statutory (enacted legislation)
Statutory/Regulatory Citation IC 6-6-2.5-1.5 (July 1, 2006) is amended to define biodiesel as a renewable, biodegradable, mono alkyl ester combustible liquid fuel derived from agricultural plant oils or animal fats that meets American Society for Testing and Materials specifications D6751-03a Standard Specification for Biodiesel Fuel (B100) Blend Stock for Distillate Fuels, as well as other fuels of the same derivation capable of use in the generation of power for the propulsion of a motor vehicle, airplane or motorboat. This section also defined blended biodiesel to be a blend of biodiesel with petroleum diesel fuel so that the volume percentage of biodiesel in the blend is at least two percent (2%).
