57-43.2-01. Definitions. As used in this chapter, unless the context otherwise requires:2. "Biodiesel, designated B100" means a fuel comprised of mono-alkyl esters of long chain fatty acids derived from vegetable oil or animal fats that meets American society for testing materials specification D 6751.
