What's needed for a successful program? NH does not have legislative authority nor published regulations to conduct fuel testing in the state. Funds for staff and equipment for internal testing or funds for testing at an outside lab are required.

AUTHORITY

Fuel Authority Regulatory (state regulations); Statutory (enacted legislation)

Statutory/Regulatory Citation Biodiesel is a renewable diesel fuel substitute that is composed of mono-alkyl esters of long chain fatty acids, is derived from vegetable oils or animal fats and meets the requirements of the American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM) specification D6751. Biodiesel is considered a renewable energy source. (Reference New Hampshire Revised Statutes Title XXXIV, Chapter 362-A:1-a)
