What's needed for a successful program? Changes in the Nevada Administrative Code that apply to biodiesel substitute D6751 for PS121 regarding B100, blends between B5 and B20 must conform to D7467 and B5 and below must meet D975. Hearings will be held in September and the Board of Agriculture will approve these changes during their meeting in December. The Legislative Council Bureau will most likely approve the changes in Jan 2010 prior to final publication.
