What's needed for a successful program? W&M conducts quarterly surveillance testing for all B100 imported into and produced in the state. Tests required are noted below and include Cold Soak Filtration. The 2% biodiesel mandate for the 9 northwestern counties is now effective and the mandate will be effective in remainder of the state on 1 October 2009.

AUTHORITY

Fuel Authority Statutory (enacted legislation); Regulatory (state regulations)

Statutory/Regulatory Citation House Bill 2210, effective July 2007 defines biodiesel as "Biodiesel" means a motor vehicle fuel consisting of mono-alkyl esters of long chain fatty acids derived from vegetable oils, animal fats or other nonpetroleum resources, not including palm oil, designated as B100 and complying with ASTM D 6751." Oregon amended OAR 603-027, Motor Fuel Quality Regulations to Implement House Bill 2210 and Senate Bill 1079.
